REPORT ON FIELD VISIT TO MILK DAIRY

PLAN OF THE VISIT

On 29th October 2022, our project team consisting of two staffs from the Department of Public Health Dentistry, 14 interns, 7 third year students and supporting staff started from Annoor Dental College and Hospital at 9.00 am and reached PDDP (Peoples Dairy Development Project) milk dairy situated at Kuttilakkara, Kalady, Ernakulam District at 10:00 am. We then did a detailed study of step-by-step procedure of milk production at PDDP milk dairy under the guidance of Mr. Jithin Jose, Assistant Plant Manager.

PURPOSE OF VISIT

Milk is an essential dietary constituent and one of the best natural resources of essential amino acids for human nutrition. The production of quality milk and milk products begins on the farm and continues through further handling, processing and distribution. As a health professional, it is extremely important to understand the process behind collection of milk from the cattle to the distribution of milk to the consumers without its degradation and contamination. Visit to the milk dairy is also a part of the academic curriculum in BDS prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences. This project was undertaken with the above objectives in mind.

PDDP MILK PLANT

PEOPLES' DAIRY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (PDDP) is a Charitable Society under the Travancore Cochin Literary Scientific and Charitable Societies. Today PDDP collects, processes and distributes nearly 1 lakh litres of milk and milk products per day on behalf of more than 200 societies owned by around 30 thousand member farmers.Fr. Joseph Muttumana is the Founder Chairman of PDDP.


Our trip ended by around 2pm. It can be concluded that the trip was successful and we believed that our objective was achieved.




