Dear Secretary

As part of Swachhata Pakhwada - Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) 2023, a massive cleanliness drive led by people is envisaged to be held on 1st Oct '23, at 10.00 am across the country as a tribute to Mahatma Gandhi on the eve of his birth anniversary on 2st Oct '23. Hon'ble Prime Minister and other dignitaries would also be joining the swachhata activities on ground.

- For this, the following urgent actions are needed:
 - i) Ministries to identify their field units that will execute cleanliness events on 1st Oct '23.
 - ii) Each field unit will be required to identify a site either in rural or urban areas where cleanliness activities will be undertaken with public participation. Site must be selected with care so as to have improved cleanliness post the activity.
 - iii) The Ministry should either enter the details of the site and events by itself on the portal 'Swachhata Hi Seva' (https://swachhatahiseva.com/) or enable the field unit to have login credentials to enter the details directly on the website. Once the events are created, the field units should widely publicise through local communication platforms.
 - iv) All these created events will be available on a map which citizens can view and choose the event they want to join by going through the options that will be available on the portal.
 - v) On 1st Oct, the organizing field unit must ensure that actual cleaning activity takes place at 10 am with the volunteers contributing at least one hour of shramdaan resulting in visible cleanliness.
- 3. To facilitate the process, an online preparatory meeting is being scheduled on 23rd Sept at 2.30 pm with all Ministries (link is being shared). It is requested to depute Nodal officers along with their teams to attend the same. A demonstration of the portal will be provided during meeting. In addition, a dedicated handholding support for Ministries is being organised on 25th Sept, 11 am onwards. A brief note on the key aspects for 1st Oct '23 is enclosed for your kind information and necessary action.

On June 22, 2023, Annoor Dental College & Hospital, in association with the local police authorities, organized an awareness program on cybercrime. The event aimed to educate and empower the 1st Year and 2nd Year BDS students with essential knowledge about cyber threats, online security, and digital safety. The event was made possible with the support and expertise of Mr. Ajesh KP, a Kerala Police Janamytri Trainer, EKSATH initiative of the Government of Kerala's Central Region.

The event was specifically designed to equip the dental students with the knowledge and skills needed to protect themselves and their future dental practices from the growing threat of cybercrime. The collaboration between Annoor Dental College and the local police was instrumental in creating a safe and secure online environment for the students and the dental community at large.

The event began with a formal inauguration ceremony, attended by member of Management: Adv T.S Rasheed, Principal, Vice Principal, faculty members & Students. Welcome address was given by Dr, Josey Mathew, HOD, Dept of Conservative Dentistry. Mr. Ajesh KP conveyed the importance of understanding cyber threats in the context of a dental profession increasingly



The seminar on tobacco cessation in dental clinics was held on 5.6.23, with the aim of shedding light on the critical role of dental professionals in helping patients quit tobacco use organized by the Departments of Oral Pathology, Oral Medicine & Public Health Dentistry. The event featured two prominent speakers, Dr. Moni Kuriakose, who discussed the 'Why' behind tobacco cessation in dental clinics, and Dr. Rita Caroline, who provided insights into 'How' to conduct effective tobacco cessation counseling.

Session 1: Dr. Moni Kuriakose on 'Why Tobacco Cessation in Dental Clinics':

Dr. Moni Kuriakose, an esteemed dental practitioner and expert in oral health, opened the seminar with a compelling presentation on the importance of integrating tobacco cessation into dental practice. He highlighted several key reasons:

Oral Health Impact: Dr. Kuriakose emphasized how tobacco use is a major risk factor for oral health issues, including gum disease, tooth loss, and oral cancers. Dental professionals are at the forefront of identifying these problems early.

Enhanced Treatment Outcomes: He explained how quitting tobacco before dental procedures can significantly improve treatment outcomes, reduce complications, and speed up healing.

Patient Trust: Dr. Kuriakose stressed that patients trust their dental practitioners and are more likely to heed their advice on quitting tobacco, making dental clinics an ideal setting for intervention.

Overall Health: The link between tobacco use and systemic health issues was discussed, highlighting that dental professionals can contribute to holistic patient well-being.

Session 2: Dr. Rita Caroline on 'Tobacco Cessation Counseling - How to Do?':

Dr. Rita Caroline, a renowned expert in tobacco cessation counseling, provided practical guidance on conducting effective counseling sessions in dental clinics:

She stressed the importance of assessing the patient's tobacco use history, readiness to quit, and nicotine dependence to tailor counseling strategies. Dr. Caroline introduced motivational interviewing techniques to elicit the patient's own motivations and reasons for quitting. She also discussed various behavioral strategies, such as setting quit dates, managing cravings, and coping with triggers.

The role of pharmacotherapy and how dental practitioners can work in collaboration with other healthcare providers was also touched upon.

Post-Lunch Session: Counseling for Patients:

Following the informative sessions by the speakers, a hands-on post-lunch session was conducted, where five patients were counseled for tobacco cessation. This practical application allowed dental practitioners to practice the techniques discussed earlier.


The inauguration of OPMD clinic for screening of potentially malignant disorders were done by Dr Moni Kuriakose.

This event marked a significant step towards a tobacco-free and healthier



future for both dental practitioners and their patients.



356 commuters signed on the signature board in support of our campaign. Overall there was


