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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

This document constitutes a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made on 24th August,2023 between Nirmala College of Pharmacy, Muvattupuzha, Kerala and Annoor Dental College, Muvattupuzha Town, Kerala here in after referred to as "the two Institutions" have jointly developed this memorandum of understanding to strengthen, promote collaboration and develop cooperation in the field of academic programmes related to pharmacy courses, as well as the development of activities for the purpose of mutual recognition.

This MOU is signed in view of exploring the possibilities between the parties in terms of research projects, joint organization of seminars, conferences, and training programmes including exchange of faculties, students, professionals, technicians, and academics for mutual benefit of both the institutions

- 1. The two Institutions jointly agree as follows:
 - a) To exchange information on research and educational programmes
 - b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

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- c) To jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- d) To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- e) To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- f) To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate and Post Graduate levels for limited periods of time for purpose of peer-time academic activities and lectures.
- g) Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material: Nirmala College Pharmacy and Annoor Dental College will exchange information on research and educational programmes and teaching/learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- h) Joint Conferences, workshops and short-term courses: NCP and Annoor Dental College agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between NCP and Annoor Dental College Intellectual Property: NCP and Annoor Dental College agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MOU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.
- i) Co-ordination: Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee, consisting of (a) Principal of NCP, Academic Director/Dean of NCP, (b) Principal of Annoor Dental, Academic Director/Dean and (C)College Programme coordinator from the side of NCP, and (d) Programme Coordinator from the side of Annoor dental College will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions

2. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective for **Three years**, from the date of signing in the first instance and shall be subject to change, renewal and termination by mutual consent. A party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding for convenience and at any time and for any reason by giving three months' notice in writing to the other party

3. The MOU will be amended with the consent of the two institutions as a written appendage executed by authorized individuals of both institutions. Such appendage once approved by both institutions will become part of this MOU

4. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be construed and governed in accordance with the laws of India.

5. In case of the involvement of funds for initiation, conduction and development of the specific activities, the separate Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) can be signed between the two Institutions



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Whereas MCS Hospital is a private hospital having 100 beds and whereas Annoor Dental College & Hospital is an Educational Institution in Dentistry conducting BDS and MDS programs.

Annoor Dental College & Hospital, requested MCS Hospital to provide practical training in General Medicine, General Surgery and allied sciences to BDS/MDS students of Annoor Dental College & Hospital, as per the list of students and schedule submitted by Annoor Dental College & Hospital at MCS Hospital and MCS Hospital has agreed to extend support to Annoor Dental College & Hospital as requested.

Annoor Dental College & Hospital will prepare and submit the list of students and schedule of practical training sections to be held at MCS Hospital, in advance. Annoor Dental College & Hospital will ensure proper discipline of their students while taking training at MCS Hospital.

In the event of any dispute or difference between the parties hereto relating to the interpretation, construction, fulfillment or otherwise of the terms and conditions under this agreement, such dispute or difference shall be settled first mutually between the parties, failing which, the same shall be settled by the process of Arbitration that is governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, before a tribunal comprising of three arbitrators.MCS Hospital and Annoor Dental College & Hospital, are to nominate two arbitrators and the third arbitrator is to be jointly nominated by the two arbitrators that are nominated by the parties.

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The Arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English and all the cost of the arbitration shall be borne equally by the parties hereto. The arbitral tribunal shall be entitled to give interim awards, interim orders and interim directions and the same shall be binding on both the parties. The seat of arbitration shall be at Muvattupuzha. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. The courts in Ernakulam, Kerala, India shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any and all disputes arising under this agreement, subject to the arbitration provisions set forth above. This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") dated the 5th day of August, 2021 is entered into by and between:

ANNOOR EDUCATIONAL TRUST, a Society located at Puthuppady P.O, Perumattom, Muvattupuzha, Ernakulam District, Kerala. (hereinafter referred to as ANNOOR" or "Partner", which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to its successors and permitted assigns);

and

KARKINOS HEALTHCARE PRIVATE LIMITED, a company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, and having its registered office at 702, 7th floor, Neelkanth Business Park, Kirol Village, Near Bus Depot Vidyavihar, Mumbai 400086 (hereinafter referred to as "Karkinos" or "KHPL", which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns).

ANNOOR and **KHPL** may hereinafter be referred to individually as a "**Party**" and collectively as the "**Parties**".

WHEREAS:

A. ANNOOR runs a Annoor Dental College & Hospital, Muvattupuzha. It was founded in the year 2003 by Late, Janab T. M. Seethy Haji. Annoor Dental College & Hospital, Muvattupuzha is approved by Ministry of Health, Govt. of India, Dental Council of India, New Delhi and is affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Annoor has earned high level reputation over the past 15 years. Annoor is committed to provide selfless service to humanity.

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Karkinos is a purpose driven organization engaged in the development of an end-to-end technology driven oncology focused managed healthcare plat form for providing better, faster, and wider access to and treatment opportunity for the patients of non-communicable diseases primarily cancer. This healthcare platform will ensure that almost no person is deprived of care either by lack of access or affordability. The design and delivery will be through bespoke solutions for screening and prevention of non-communicable diseases primarily cancer, addressing core market needs for this specialized health care. It will use technology and artificial intelligence based continuous feedback to improvise care to our own needs and plans to scale up within India and beyond.

C. In pursuance of the above focus, **Karkinos** proposes establishing a nation-wide network of cancer centers and hospitals (the "**Network**" collectively and "**Center**" for each cancer center / hospital within the Network) as a fully integrated offering with the aim of creating a patient care model tailored to **emerging** market needs that accelerates the expansion of state-of-the-art oncology diagnosis and treatment options and which enables reach, access and affordability to all sections of society, including the indigent strata of society.

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NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES:

1. SCOPE

- 1.1 The Community Oral Lesion Surveillance Program (Program) aims to improve oral health in the community by empowering the dental fraternity for early detection of oral cancer and effective management of oral lesions in their clinics. This will improve disease outcomes by enabling early detection, and timely referral for treatment
- 1.2 Oral cancer screening and early detection is the fundamental component of the oral cancer control programme, as recommended by the National Health Mission of Government of India. Although dentists are considered the gatekeepers of oral health and many dental surgeons are actively involved in various aspects of oral cancer early detection, management, surveillance and rehabilitation, the specialty as a whole is yet to embrace comprehensive oral cancer care and get its due recognition by the public and the healthcare community.
- 1.3 The proposed population-wide project is to demonstrate the potential of dental practitioners in the overall care of cancer. As an added service, the project will attempt to empower primary care dental practitioners in diagnosing and managing oral mucosal lesions with the remote assistance of experts so that often mismanaged oral lesions can be appropriately addressed by the dentists closer to the patient's home without physical consultation by specialists
- 1.4 The Program is an initiative of the entire dental fraternity including dental colleges, dental clinics the Indian Dental Association, and supported by Karkinos Healthcare (KH). The dental colleges will serve as knowledge partner, dental clinics, IDA will execute the project in the community and KH will provide technical support for training, pathology and care coordination using technology

- 1.5 The principal program components are as follows:
 - Oral lesion project management team representatives from the academic space, dental clinics, specialists, pathologists, technologists.
 - Learning Management System and Certification of dental practitioners training via the Karkinos platform and certification by Uni London and Kings College
 - Establishment of referral networks with oral lesion management units distributed across the target geography
 - Implementation of care coordination pathways
- 1.6 The program will be piloted in Ernakulam and Idukki districts. Dental surgeons who are passionate about the goal and willing to participate would undergo the training program. The training would be in two phases; virtual and hand-on.
- 1.7 The virtual session would cover topics including; Oral lesion identification, Biopsy procedure, Oral Lesion management, Introduction to use of PoC technology for Oral Screening and Case discussion forum. This would be followed by an immersion at an identified clinic/college during which training on biopsy, laser and use of Point of Care technology will be demonstrated.
- 1.8 Pursuant to this **MOU**, Parties will discuss plans for creation of an ecosystem that provides comprehensive support to healthcare innovators and supports the rapid development of life-saving devices, multidisciplinary research and development, and early detection and improved cancer care delivery using artificial intelligence and other technologies
- 1.9 **Karkinos** to Provide technical support for training, guidance for treatment and facility at its central lab for sample processing
- 1.10 Annoor will screen the patients and manage as per the treatment guidelines as agreed.

2. DESIRED OUTCOMES

- 2.1 The desired outcomes of the program are:
 - Early detection and surveillance for prevention of oral cancer
 - Micro level reach enabling closer monitoring and timely care provision
 - This complements the tobacco control program and addresses the limitations of deaddiction.
 - Capacity building and empowerment of local resources.
 - Technology innovations and robust information system.

3. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- 3.1 Each Party represents and warrants to the other Party that:
 - 3.1.1 it is duly organized and validly existing under Indian laws
 - 3.1.2 it has full power and authority to execute, deliver and perform this MOU and to consummate the transactions contemplated hereby;

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- 3.1.3 this MoU has been duly and validly executed and delivered by it, and constitutes legal and valid obligations enforceable against it in accordance with the terms of this MoU; and
- 3.1.4 neither the execution and the delivery of this MOU nor the consummation of the transactions contemplated hereby will violate or conflict with any law, regulation, any provisions of its charter documents, any judgment, order or decree of any court, tribunal or other authority or any contract to which it is a party.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY

ARTICLE 3

ACADEMIC RESEARCH PROJECTS AND TRAINING PROGRAMME

- 1. RC, ADCH will encourage students to join UNIBIOSYS for carrying out of their Academic projects.
- 2. The participating students will continue as students for Degree of their parent institution **RC**, **ADCH** and will be enrolled as affiliate (or non-award, non Degree) students in the host institution, **UNIBIOSYS**.
- 3. For every student under course programme the host institution will send academic project work reports of the students in the courses to the parent institution at the end of the tenure/term.
- 4. RC, ADCH will send the students to host institution for a mutually approved duration of time.
- 5. RC, ADCH will nominate students for the academic programme, and forward relevant data concerning the students to the host institution. The host institution will decide on the acceptability of the students nominated, and identify an appropriate supervisor. It is expected that the host institution will accept the nomination except in extra ordinary circumstances; and in such cases the parent institution will submit another application for consideration.
- 6. Every student under the programme shall pursue their research programme which is developed in consultation with the parent institution, and which is not in conflict with the regulations of the host institution. The appointed supervisor at the host institution will provide a report on the student to the parent institution on completion of his/her tenure/term. However, the two supervisors will jointly guide the students, until they complete their theses and are awarded degree.
- 7. Project fees of students have to be paid to the host institution, before the start of training & academic project and no fee needs to be paid at the parent institution.
- 8. The faculty concerned of the RC, ADCH will be responsible for arranging the study programme of the student
- 9. UNIBIOSYS will provide various training programme for the benefit of students in the RC, ADCH for a fees mutually agreed upon by the two institutions in the RC, ADCH premises. RC, ADCH shall provide a space and other amenities for providing such training programme and the Faculty and course material will be provided by UNIBIOSYS.
